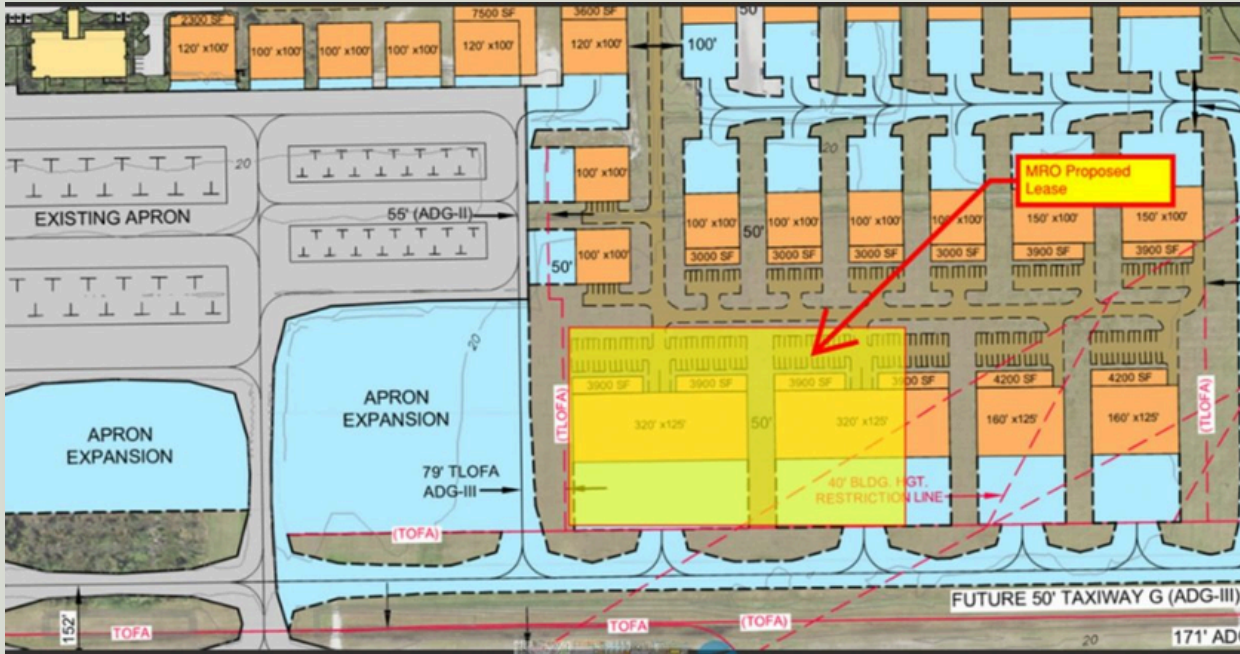




EXCITING NEWS FOR THE FUTURE OF AEROSPACE IN CHARLOTTE COUNTY!



The Charlotte County Airport Authority has approved a land lease agreement with NAS MRO Services LLC, a Miami-area firm, to construct a state-of-the-art hangar at Punta Gorda Airport. This new 100,000 square foot hangar will be large enough to accommodate three narrow-body commercial jets for maintenance and repairs. NAS MRO Services LLC can now move forward with the application, permitting, and construction phases, thanks to the CCAA's approval on June 20. Choosing Punta Gorda for their first airside maintenance and repair overhaul facility was influenced by the presence of the Aviation Maintenance School at the airport and the tremendous opportunities awaiting PGD according to Nestor Camacho, Director of Operations and COO of NAS MRO.
