Phase I has been fully leased. Phase 2 is now leasing. Phase 3 and 4 are pre-leasing. Each phase will be a gray shell building that can be divided into up to eight $5,000 \pm$ SF spaces measuring 50' x 100' each. Each unit has two roll-up doors – either dock high access with 8' x 10' roll-up loading doors or 12' x 14' grade level roll-up loading doors. In addition, each unit has a front and rear entry door and two restrooms.
