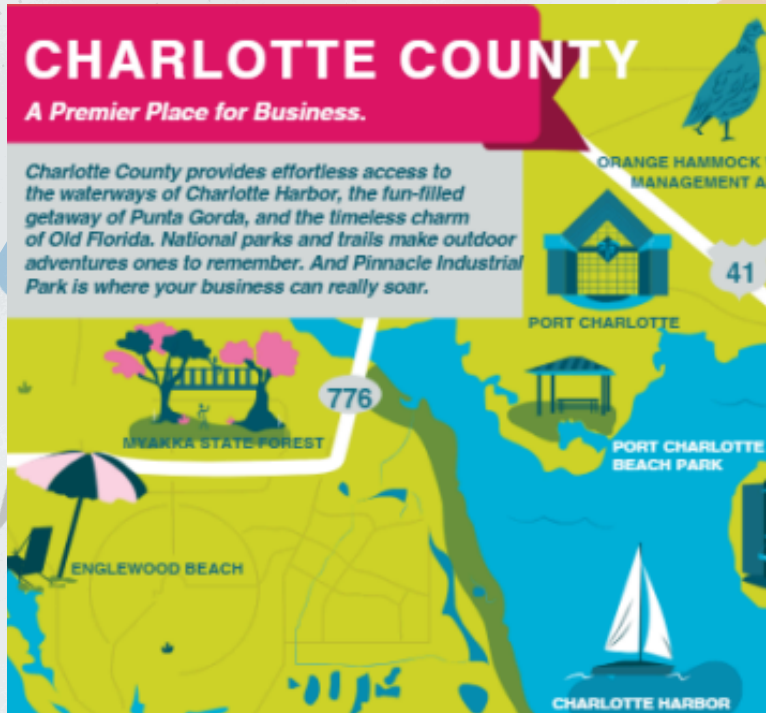

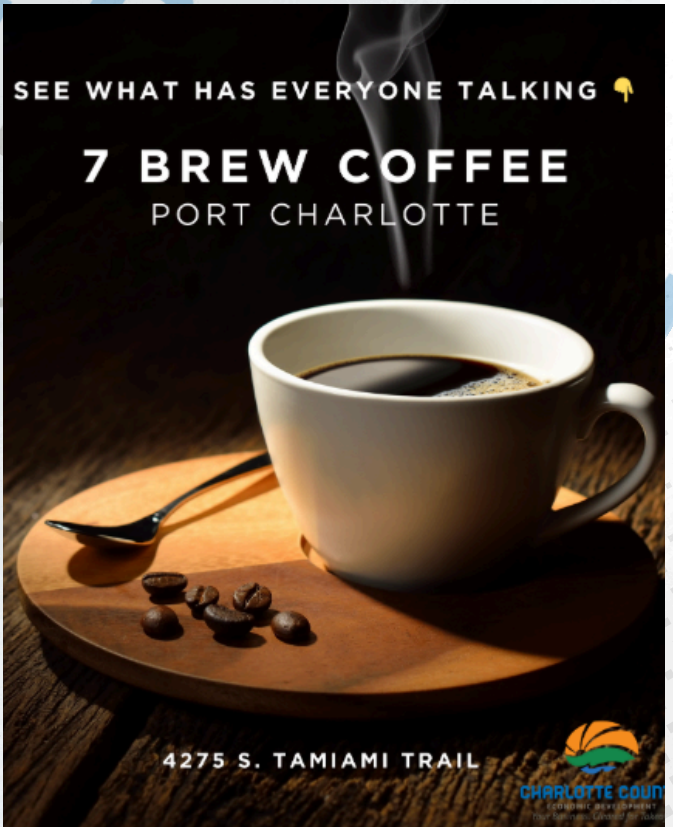
7 Brew Coffee Brews Up Growth in Port Charlotte

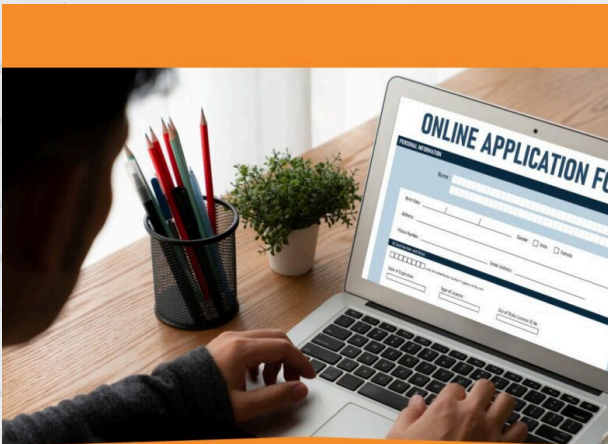

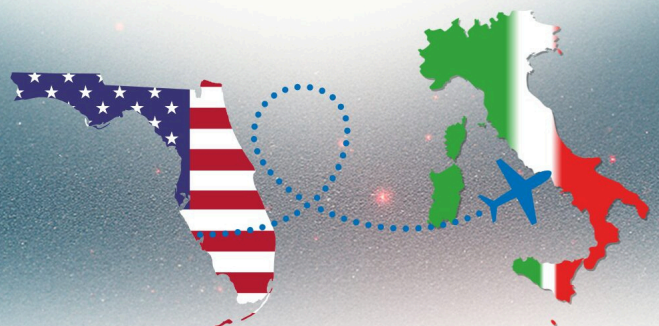

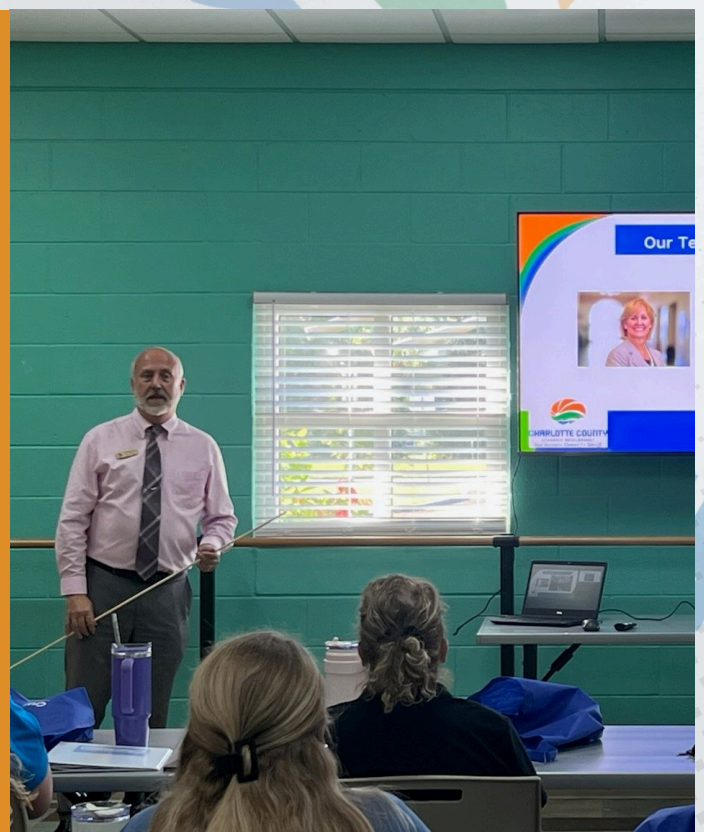

SWFL ROTARY CLUB: SERVICE ABOVE SELF IN CHARLOTTE COUNTY

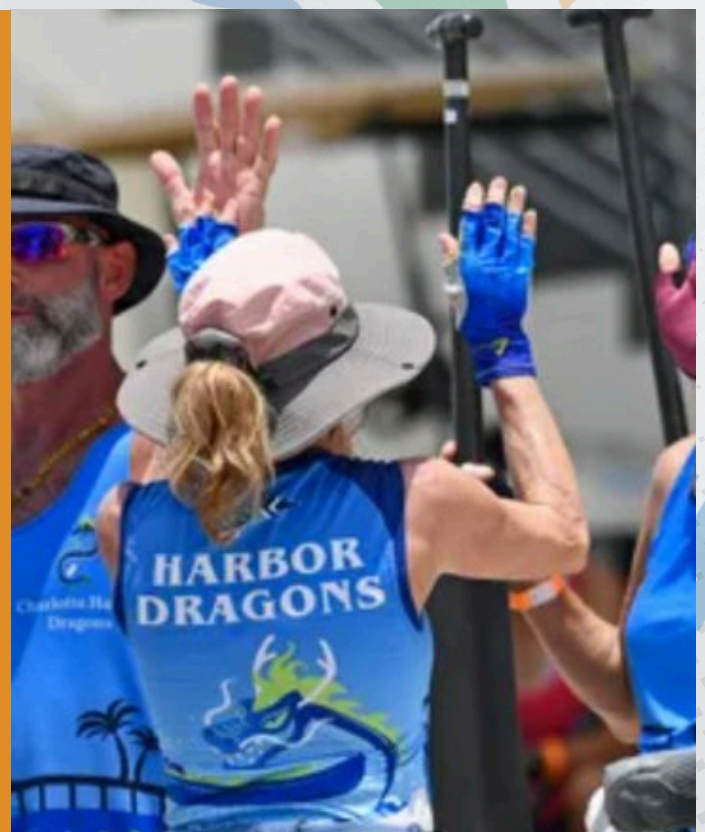
